Scholarship Promotes Social Entrepreneurship Elfenworks, Kiev Taras Shevchenko Partnership Flourishes

(San Mateo, CA), May 1, 2017 –The Elfenworks Foundation, in partnership with Kiev Taras Shevchenko National University and Elfenworks Productions, LLC, today announced the selection of the winner of the University's first-ever scholarship for budding social entrepreneurs at the Elfenworks Scholarship Competition. The winner, Vitaly Oleksyuk, was announced on Tuesday, April 25th amidst joyous celebration. The event was led by Dr. Valeriy Kopyka, Director of the Institute of International Relations. Social entrepreneurs from across the country were on hand, showing the breadth and depth of efforts already underway.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony for an Elfenworks Center on Social Entrepreneurship at the university was graced by two adorable children bearing koroval, a traditional bread. Addressing students, Elfenworks CEO Lauren Speeth, who was honored with both an honorary doctorate and the honorary title of Professor at the event, compared the making of this bread to the process of social entrepreneurship itself, starting with the vision for beautiful bread. To bring it to fruition requires various special skills, including decoration, and there will be local variation. The bakers, who work in partnership, don't duplicate each other's efforts. The process involves feedback, such as knowing if the bread has risen, if the oven is hot enough, and so on. Stay the course until the work is complete, then share in the credit, and the whole community is the better for the effort.

The university is a powerhouse, and there's every indication that the students of social entrepreneurship will "cook up" exceptional results. In the inaugural year alone, an initial pool of one hundred thirty five participants were reduced to twenty four finalists in a second, juried phase, assessing their in-depth knowledge of the field, its current status and importance for Ukraine, as well as their own personal involvement and vision. This year's finalists, Anna Kikesheva, Vitaly Oleksyuk, Valeriia Slinko and Oleksander Yaroshenko met with the Elfenworks team for in-depth discussions during their ten-day stay in the country. "I congratulate every one of the students who submitted for this scholarship," reiterated Elfenworks Executive Director Kenneth Tam, adding, "Each of the finalists was a winner in our eyes, confirming that they indeed hold the key to tomorrow's hope."

Preparations are already in place for the coming year's competition, to take place at the Institute of International Relations of the Kiev Taras Shevchenko National University.
